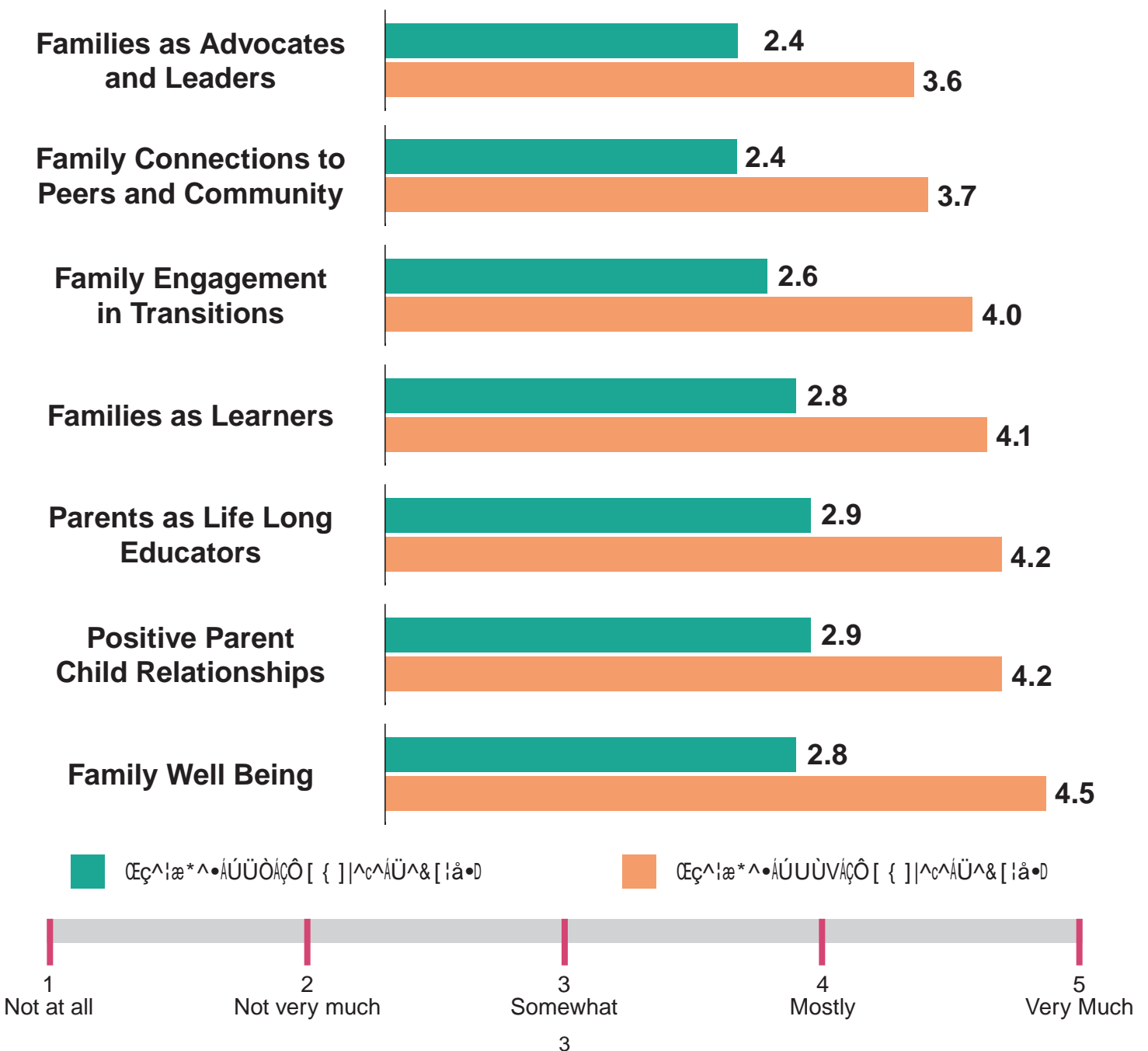

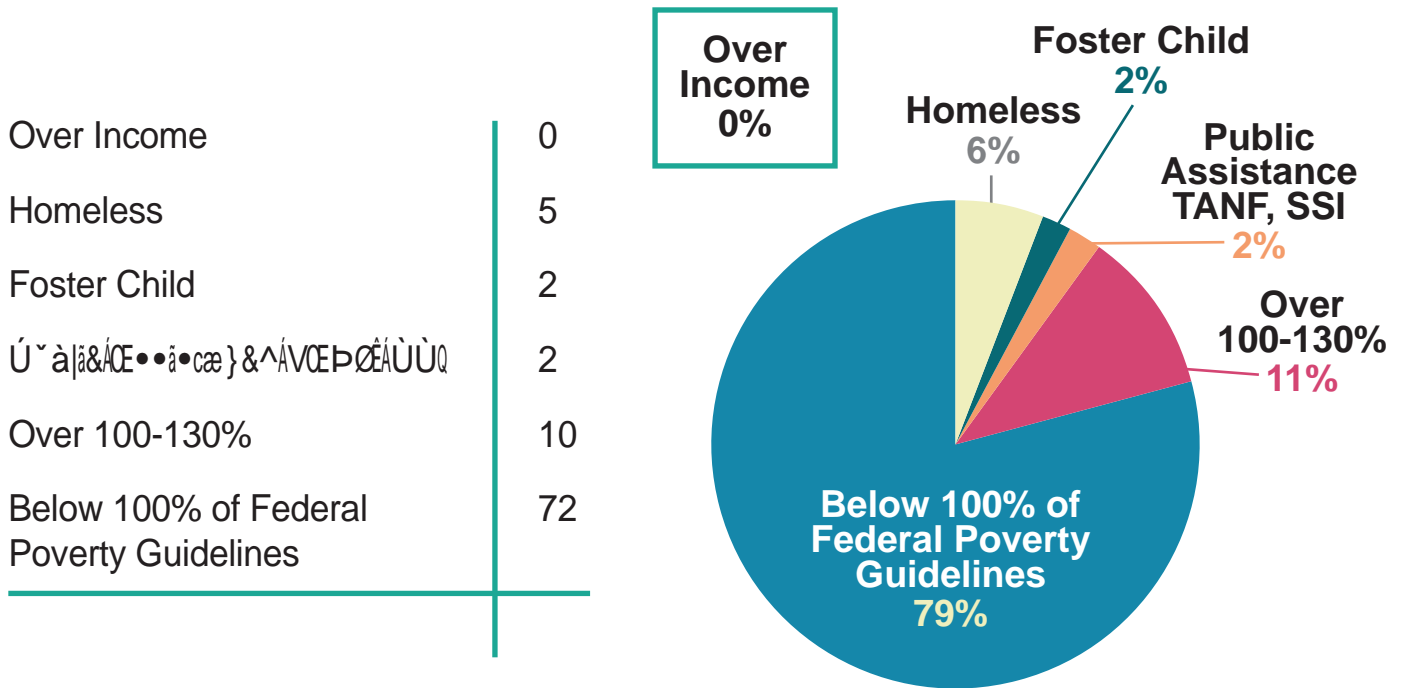

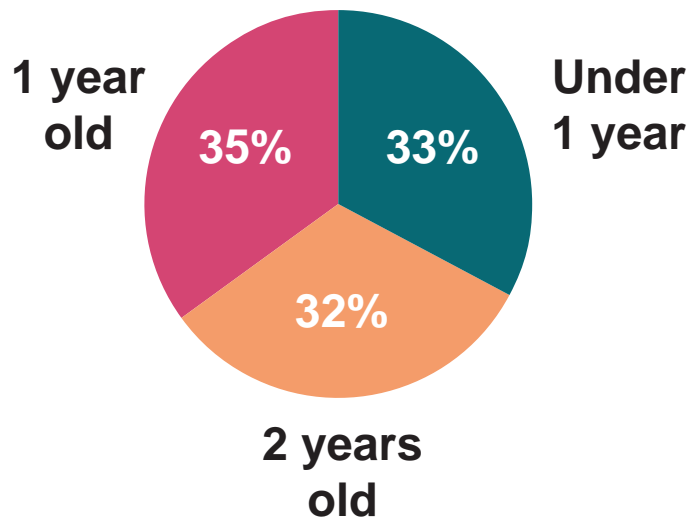
This chart shows how parents report their progress while enrolled in the program in the different domains based on the scale below.



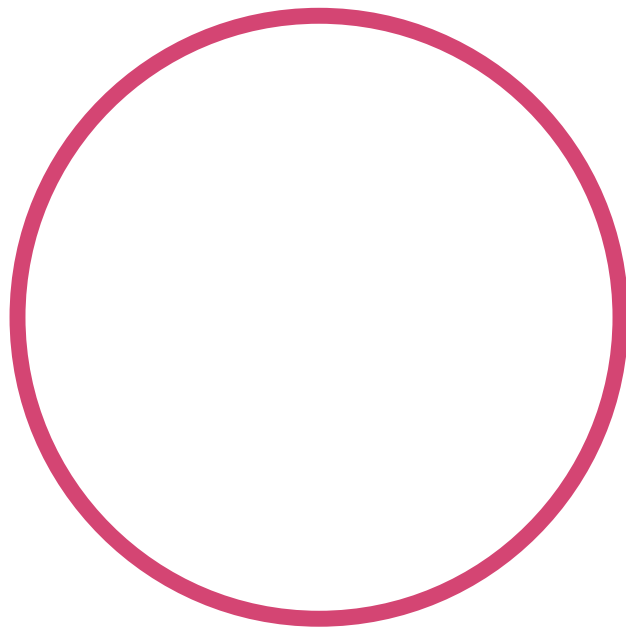
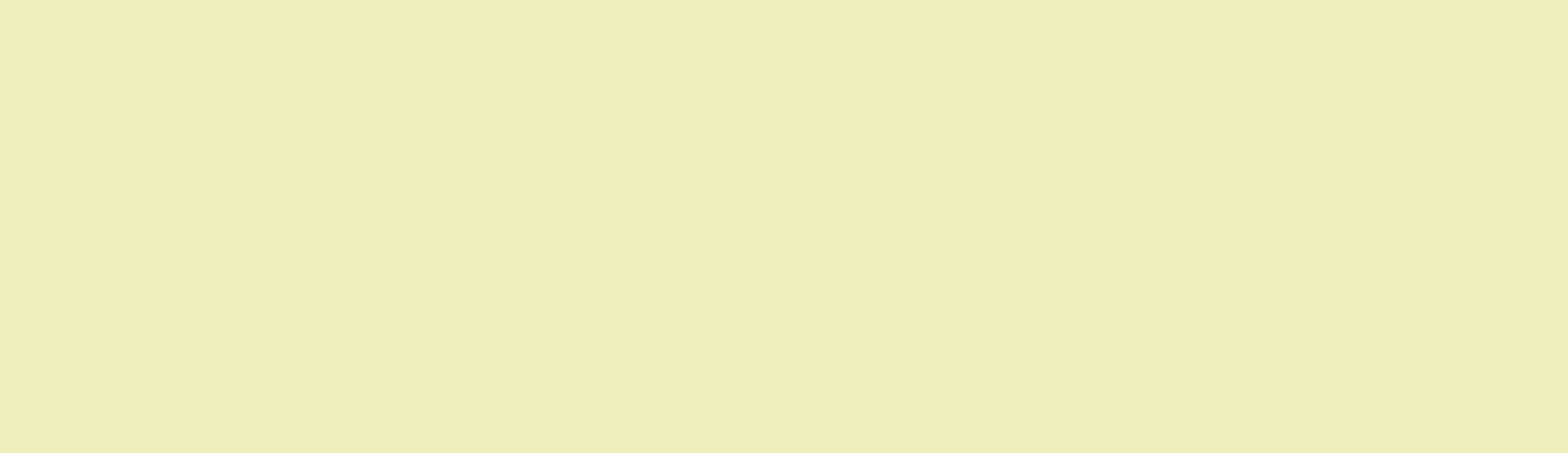
Cumulative Enrollment by Eligibility: 91 Children

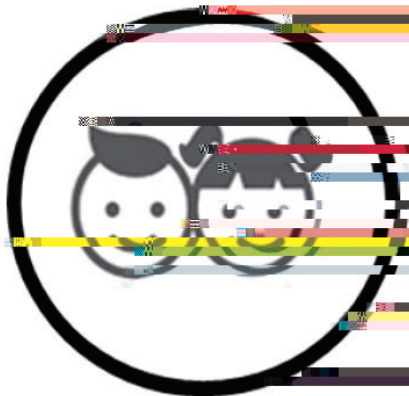
2018-2019 Health Data for Enrolled Children

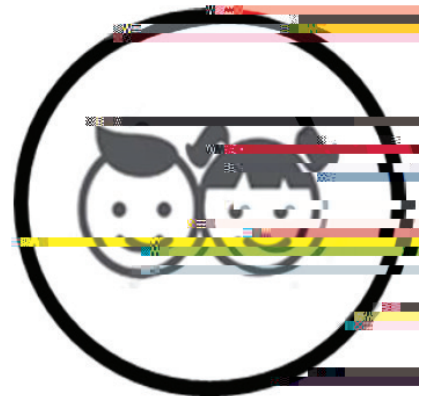

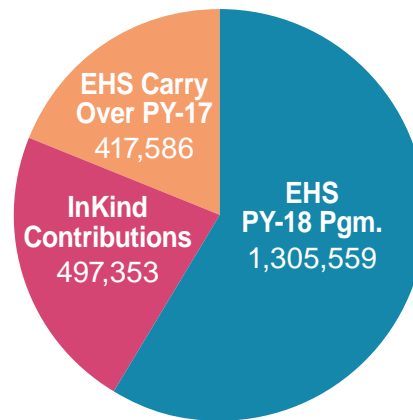

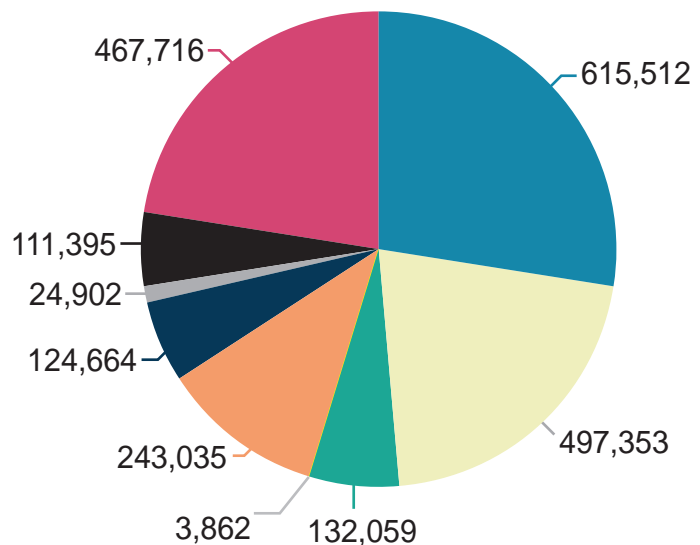

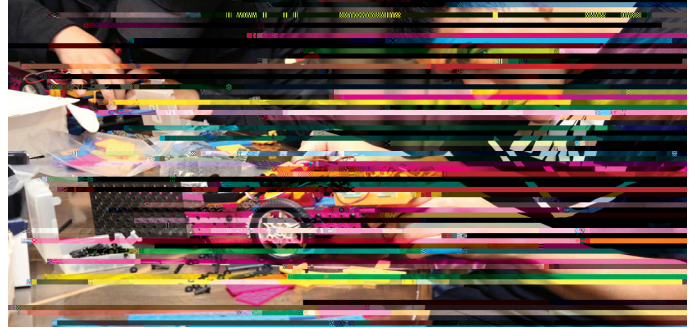
